
NSU COP AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS: Fall 2024

Application Deadline: March 31, 2024

The following NSU COP student scholarships are available for application at this time and will be awarded in Fall 2024. Scholarships are awarded based upon the criteria of the given scholarship, which may include academic success and financial need. Students are advised to review the criteria for each available scholarship and identify why they are a good fit within the free text fields of the application, where applicable. Students are also encouraged to provide details of financial need and/or academic excellence when possible.

ELGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Only current NSU COP students are eligible to apply.
- Scholarship applications must be completed and submitted online through the above website.
- The application deadline **is March 31st, 2024, at 11:59 PM EST.**
- Some scholarships require a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) as an eligibility criterion.
- All applicants must provide at least one professional letter of recommendation. The recommender can be any individual who can impartially vouch for the applicant's qualifications such as a faculty member or past/current employer.

SCHOLARSHIPS 2023/2024

1. Walgreens Nivia Santiago and Georgia Lehoczky Endowed Community Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$4,523.54 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who reside in Puerto Rico and are attending the NSU Puerto Rico campus. Preference shall also be given to students who seek employment in Puerto Rico post-graduation in a community setting.

The award **recipient (not applicant)** is required to submit a 250-word essay explaining his/her interest and vision for community pharmacy and submit the essay to the Interim Chairs of NSU COP Student Scholarship Committee.

2. Walgreens Roy Ripak and Georgia Lehoczky Endowed Community Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$4,523.54 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who reside in Miami. Preference shall also be given to students who seek employment post-graduation in a community setting.

The award **recipient (not applicant)** is required to submit a 250-word essay explaining his/her interest and vision for community pharmacy and submit the essay to the Interim Chairs of NSU COP Student Scholarship Committee.

3. Walgreens Richard Ashworth Endowed Community Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$4,523.54 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who seek employment post-graduation in a community setting.

The award **recipient (not applicant)** is required to submit a 250-word essay explaining his/her interest and vision for community pharmacy and submit the essay to the Chair of NSU COP Student Scholarship Committee.

4. Pharmacy Achievement Scholarship (previously the Dean's Scholarship) (NO FAFSA required)

Award Amount: \$5,000 (six scholarships to be awarded in 2024)

Requirement: Provides awards to pharmacy students based on academic performance and college engagement.

5. CVS Pharmacy, Inc. Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA not required)

Award Amount: (\$3,757.50 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate good academic standing. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who are interested in a community pharmacy.

The award recipient (not applicant) is required to submit a 250-word essay explaining his/her interest and vision for community pharmacy and submit the essay to the Interim Chairs of NSU COP Student Scholarship Committee.

6. Walgreens Puerto Rico Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$318.00 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who reside in Puerto Rico and are attending the NSU Puerto Rico Campus. Preference shall also be given to students who seek employment in Puerto Rico post-graduation in a community pharmacy setting.

The award recipient (not applicant) is required to compose a 250-word essay explaining his/her interest and vision for community pharmacy practice and submit the essay to the Interim Chairs of NSU COP Scholarship Committee.

7. Walgreen Endowed Community Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$3,684.79 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who have an interest in a community pharmacy.

8. The Walgreens Specialty Pharmacy Endowed Scholarship Fund (FASFA required)

Award Amount: (\$3,000, awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Fund shall be used to award scholarships to one or more professional students with academic merit and financial need who are enrolled in the NSU Barry and Judy Silverman College of Pharmacy and pursuing a Doctor of Pharmacy degree. Preference shall be given to students who have an interest in specialty pharmacy and who seek employment post-graduation in a specialty community pharmacy setting.

The award recipient (not applicant) is required to submit a 250-word essay on their interest in becoming a pharmacist and submit the essay to the Interim Chairs of NSU COP Scholarship Committee.

9. Walgreen Diversity & Inclusion Excellence Award Scholarship (NO FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$2,500 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirement: Scholarship awarded to pharmacy students with an interest in community pharmacy and meet at least one of the following criteria: i. embraces diversity and promotes diversity and inclusion initiatives on campus; represent an underrepresented minority group.

10. Walgreen Multilingual Scholarship (NO FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$2,500 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirement: Provide award to a single student who is fluent speaking in one or more languages in addition to English with an interest in community pharmacy.

11. Raj Mantena, RPh Scholar Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: \$1,859.06 (two scholarships awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic excellence. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment to support scholarships for pharmacy students at NSU. Preferences shall be given to students attending the NSU Palm Beach Campus.

12. COP Community Leadership Council Scholarship (No FAFSA required)

Award Amount: \$5,000 (four scholarships to be awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Students must demonstrate academic excellence and growth as a leader (executive level officer of a pharmacy organization or class) throughout their time at the College of Pharmacy. Awards are based on available funds annually.

The award recipient (not applicant) is required to submit a 250-word essay on their interest in becoming a pharmacist and submit the essay to the Interim Chairs of NSU COP Scholarship Committee.

13. National Association of Chain Stores Foundation Pharmacy Partners Scholarship (No FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$2,400; award amount determined for 2024)

Requirements: Provide award to student with good academic standing and have an interest in a career in a community pharmacy. The student must complete at least one professional year of pharmacy school with strong oral and written communication skills and excel at patient counseling.

14. College of Pharmacy Endowed Scholarship (No FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$1,767.86 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Provides awards to a student who demonstrates an active interest in advocacy efforts for the profession of pharmacy while maintaining a record of academic excellence. The Dean has sole discretion on granting the scholarship. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment.

15. Richard & Hannah Stern Endowment Scholarship (NO FAFSA required)

Award Amount: \$1,543.01 (two scholarships awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirement: Provides awards to pharmacy students who have good academic standing; evidence of leadership; community involvement.

16. Dr. Goar Alvarez and Family Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$254.06 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic merit and financial. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who have an interest in independent community pharmacy practice, pharmacy leadership experience, and a strong record of community service.

The award recipient (not applicant) is required to compose a 250-word essay explaining his/her interest and vision for independent community pharmacy practice and submit the essay to the Interim Chairs of NSU COP Scholarship Committee

17. Gil Pharmaceutical Endowment Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$1,346.50 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic excellence. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. The award is established to support scholarships for pharmacy students studying at the NSU Palm Beach Campus.

18. Sharks Rx Alumni Society Legacy Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$1,456.86 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who exemplify leadership capabilities, interest in research activities, service to the community, and effective leadership and/or entrepreneurial skills.

19. ASR Clark Changing Lives Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$1,000 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: A student who has demonstrated a passion for serving underserved/underrepresented populations. Leadership is preferred, but not required. Student must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA. Awards are based on available funds annually.

20. Jose/Carla Rey Changing Lives Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$1,000 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Provides award to an outstanding pharmacy student with very good academic performance (3.5 GPA or higher); who has demonstrated sustained service to the College; and who has evidence of sustained leadership (executive-level officer of a pharmacy organization). Awards are based on available funds annually.

21. In memory of Talal Khanfar by Dr. Nile M. Khanfar and wife Dr. Lenda I. Murab Changing Lives Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$1,000 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Provides award to benefit academically talented students for whom financial assistance will make a difference in being able to attend at the NSU Palm Beach Campus. Awards are based on available funds annually.

22. CVS Health Foundation Spanish Scholarship (NO FAFSA required)

Award Amount: \$1000 (nine scholarships awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirement: Provide award to student with good academic standing and have an interest in a career in a community pharmacy. All these awards must be granted to students proficient in Spanish.

23. Publix Pharmacy Endowment Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: \$1,000 (six scholarships to be awarded in 2023) (\$6,243.42 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Provides award to P2, P3 or P4 student who demonstrates academic excellence and strong interest in community practice. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment.

24. McGory Family Changing Lives Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$1,000 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds annually.

25. Dr. Elizabeth Shepherd Changing Lives Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$1,000 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic merit and financial need. Student should demonstrate a passion for serving the geriatric population. Leadership experience preferred. Awards are based on available funds annually.

26. Shannon Wayte in Honor of Dean Michelle Clark and Dr. Elizabeth Shepherd Changing Lives Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$1,000 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic merit and financial need. Student should demonstrate a passion for serving under resourced communities. Awards are based on available funds annually.

27. COP Puerto Rico Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$2,615.65 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who reside in Puerto Rico and are attending the NSU Puerto Rico Campus. Preference shall also be given to students who exemplify leadership capabilities, interest in research activities, service to the community, and effective leadership and/or entrepreneurial skills.

28. Sheila Tischenkel Pharmacy Endowment Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$741.49 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

29. William D. Hardigan Endowment Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: (\$546.92 awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Provides awards to pharmacy students who have good academic standing; service to the College of Pharmacy; evidence of leadership; has dependents; financial need. The Dean has sole discretion on granting the scholarship. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment.

30. Paul & Ellen Magalian Endowment Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: \$500 (two scholarship awarded in 2023; award amount to be determined for 2024)

Requirements: Provides awards for students entering their P2 year and who have financial need. The Dean has sole discretion on granting the scholarship. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment.

31. Jeremy Espeut I Can Too Scholarship (No FAFSA required)

Award Amount: \$500 (to be awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Students must demonstrate academic excellence (minimum 3.5 GPA) and growth as a leader (executive level officer of a pharmacy organization or class) throughout their time at the College of Pharmacy. Awards are based on available funds annually.

The award recipient (not applicant) is required to submit a one-thousand-word essay on how they have grown as a professional or as a leader throughout their time in pharmacy school and submit the essay to the Interim Chairs of NSU COP Scholarship Committee.

32. Gregory Pierre Louis Rise Up Scholarship (FAFSA required)

Award Amount: \$750

Requirements: Students should demonstrate academic excellence (minimum 3.6 GPA), growth as a leader, service to the community, and financial need throughout their time at the NSU Barry and Judy Silverman College of Pharmacy.
