### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Only current NSU Barry and Judy Silverman College of Pharmacy students are eligible to apply.
- Scholarship applications must be completed and submitted online through the above website.
- The application deadline **is March 31st, 2025, at 11:59 PM EST.**
- Some scholarships require a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) as an eligibility criterion.
- All applicants must provide at least one professional letter of recommendation.

The following NSU Barry and Judy Silverman College of Pharmacy student scholarships are available for application at this time and will be awarded in Fall 2025. Scholarships are awarded based on the criteria of the given scholarship, which may include academic success and financial need. Students are advised to review the criteria for each available scholarship.

**SCHOLARSHIPS**  
**Academic Year 2025/2026**

**1. Pharmacy Achievement Scholarship (PAS) (previously the Dean's Scholarship) (NO FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: \$5,000 (**two** scholarships awarded in 2024)

Requirement: Provides awards to pharmacy students based on academic performance and college engagement. Awards are based on available funds annually.

**2. Barry and Judy Silverman Endowed Scholarship (NO FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: \$5,000 (**four** scholarships awarded in 2024)

Requirement: Provides awards to pharmacy students based on academic performance and evidence of leadership and community engagement. Awards are based on available funds annually.

**3. COP Community Leadership Council Scholarship (CLC) (No FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: \$5000 (**Four** scholarships awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides awards to pharmacy students demonstrating academic excellence and growth as a leader (executive level officer of a pharmacy organization or class) throughout their time at the Silverman College of Pharmacy. Awards are based on available funds annually.

**4. Walgreens Nivia Santiago and Georgia Lehoczy Endowed Community Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$4,366.10 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who reside in Puerto Rico and are attending the NSU Puerto Rico campus. Preference shall also be given to students who seek employment in Puerto Rico post-graduation, in a community setting.

**5. Walgreens Roy Ripak and Georgia Lehoczy Endowed Community Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$4,366.10 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who reside in Miami. Preference shall also be given to students who seek employment post-graduation, in a community setting.

**6. Walgreens Richard Ashworth Endowed Community Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$4,366.10 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who seek employment post-graduation in a community setting.

**7. CVS Pharmacy, Inc. Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA not required)**

Award Amount: (\$3,688.07 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating good academic standing. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who are interested in a community pharmacy.

**8. Walgreens Endowed Community Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$3,647.32 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who have an interest in community pharmacy.

**9. The Walgreens Specialty Pharmacy Endowed Scholarship (FASFA required)**

Award Amount: (\$738.70, awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to one or more professional students with academic merit and financial need who are enrolled in the NSU Barry and Judy Silverman College of Pharmacy and pursuing a Doctor of Pharmacy degree. Preference shall be given to students who have an interest in specialty pharmacy and who seek employment post-graduation in a specialty community pharmacy setting.

**10. COP Puerto Rico Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$867.07 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who reside in Puerto Rico and are attending the NSU Puerto Rico Campus. Preference shall also be given to students who exemplify leadership capabilities, interest in research activities, service to the community, and effective leadership and/or entrepreneurial skills.

**11. National Association of Chain Stores Foundation Pharmacy Partners Scholarship (No FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: \$2,600; to be awarded in 2025

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student in good academic standing and an interest in a career in a community pharmacy. The student must complete at least one professional year of pharmacy school with strong oral and written communication skills and excel at patient counseling.

**12. Raj Mantena, RPh Scholar Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: \$1,813.97 (**two** scholarships awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to pharmacy students demonstrating demonstrate academic excellence. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment to support scholarships for pharmacy students at NSU. Preferences shall be given to former Palm Beach students.

**13. Silverman College of Pharmacy Endowed Scholarship (No FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$1,650.45 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a student who demonstrates an active interest in advocacy efforts for the profession of pharmacy while maintaining a record of academic excellence. The Dean has sole discretion on granting the scholarship. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment.

**14. Richard & Hannah Stern Endowed Scholarship (NO FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: \$1,498.26 (**two** scholarships awarded in 2024)

Requirement: Provides awards to pharmacy students who have good academic standing; evidence of leadership; community involvement.

**15. Sharks Rx Alumni Society Legacy Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$3,239.93 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who exemplify leadership capabilities, interest in research activities, service to the community, and effective leadership and/or entrepreneurial skills. The award is established to support a pharmacy student studying at the NSU Fort Lauderdale Campus.

**16. Gil Pharmaceutical Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$1,305.55 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic excellence. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. The award is established to support scholarships for pharmacy students studying at the NSU Puerto Rico Campus.

**17. ASR Clark Changing Lives Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: \$1,000 to be awarded in 2025

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating a passion for serving populations with heightened healthcare needs. Leadership is preferred but not required. Student must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA. Awards are based on available funds annually.

**18. Jose/Carla Rey Changing Lives Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$1,000 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to an outstanding pharmacy student with very good academic performance (3.5 GPA or higher); who has demonstrated sustained service to the College; and who has evidence of sustained leadership (executive-level officer of a pharmacy organization). Awards are based on available funds annually.

**19. Publix Pharmacy Endowment Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: \$1,000 (**six** scholarships awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides awards to P2, P3, or P4 students who demonstrate academic excellence and a strong interest in community practice. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment.

**20. McGory Family Changing Lives Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$1,000 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds annually.

**21. Dr. Elizabeth Shepherd Changing Lives Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$1,000 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Student should demonstrate a passion for serving the geriatric population. Leadership experience preferred. Awards are based on available funds annually.

**22. Shannon Wayte in Honor of Dean Michelle Clark and Dr. Elizabeth Shepherd Changing Lives Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$1,000 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Students should demonstrate a passion for serving populations with heightened healthcare needs. Awards are based on available funds annually.

**23. Gregory Pierre Louis Rise Up Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$750 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic excellence (minimum 3.6 GPA), growth as a leader, service to the community, and financial need throughout their time at the NSU Barry and Judy Silverman College of Pharmacy. Awards are based on available funds annually.

**24. Sheila Tischenkel Pharmacy Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$646.98 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a P4 student with financial need and academic excellence. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment.

**25. William D. Hardigan Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$537.29 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to pharmacy students who have good academic standing; service to the Silverman College of Pharmacy; evidence of leadership; has dependents; financial need. The Dean has sole discretion on granting the scholarship. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment.

**26. Paul & Ellen Magalian Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$500 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award for a student entering their P2 year and who has financial need. The Dean has sole discretion on granting the scholarship. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment.

**27. Jeremy Espeut I Can Too Scholarship (No FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$500 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic excellence (minimum 3.5 GPA) and growth as a leader (executive level officer of a pharmacy organization or class) throughout their time at the Silverman College of Pharmacy. Awards are based on available funds annually.

**28. Walgreens Puerto Rico Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$3,100.39 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who reside in Puerto Rico and are attending the NSU Puerto Rico Campus. Preference shall also be given to students who seek employment in Puerto Rico post-graduation in a community pharmacy setting.

**29. Dr. Goar Alvarez and Family Endowed Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: (\$540.74 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who have an interest in independent community pharmacy practice, pharmacy leadership experience, and a strong record of community service.

**30. Lippman Endowed Scholarship Fund (NO FAFSA required) - NEW**

Award Amount: \$3,250 (zero awarded in 2024)

Requirement: Provides an award to a pharmacy student enrolled in the Silverman College of Pharmacy.

**31. Morton J. and Marie E. Morris Endowed Memorial Scholarship Fund (FAFSA required) - NEW**

Award Amount: \$1,416 minimum (zero awarded in 2024)

Requirement: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating academic merit and financial need. Awards are based on available funds generated each year from the endowment. Preference shall be given to students who exemplify leadership capabilities, interprofessional collaboration, service to the community, service to the profession of pharmacy, and effective leadership and/or entrepreneurial skills.

**32. Walgreens Pharmacy Champion Scholarship (FAFSA required)**

Award Amount: \$2500 to be awarded in 2025 (\$0 awarded in 2024)

Requirements: Provides an award to a pharmacy student demonstrating leadership, academic success, and a commitment to championing pharmacy, healthcare, and high-quality patient care in a community setting.
